Welcome

2022 proved to be a very productive year for the paws4people team. Among many accomplishments, some key highlights include: establishing a new donor database, hosting our largest ever Derby4Dogs fundraiser, and completing renovations for our CHAENEY Dormitory Building.

I am pleased to say that we have now surpassed the \$1M revenue mark for six consecutive years. This year we proudly graduated 31 Assistance and Facility Dog Teams, exceeded \$150,000 in fundraising support from Derby4Dogs, and hosted over 10 clients for Intervention Transfer Training® in our newly opened CHAENEY Dormitory Building.

Over the past 23 years I have watched paws4people grow from a "mom and pop" grassroots company with no employees and minimal Clients, to an internationally Accredited organization with over 20 full and part-time employees, serving more than 1,200 Clients nationwide.

I am eternally grateful for all the hard work every Client, employee, volunteer, and supporter has put into the paws4people family.

WOUNDED WARRIOR SERVICE DOG PROGRAM GRANT

For eight consecutive years, paws4people has been the proud recipient of the Wounded Warrior Service Dog Program (WWSDP) Grant through the Uniformed Services University of Health Sciences. The WWSDP is a competitive grant program that supports nonprofit organizations committed to connecting Service Dogs with Veterans and Service Members. This year's grant was awarded in the amount of \$734,864 in support of 12 Veteran Client/ Dog Teams.

NC GENERAL ASSEMBLY DIRECTED GRANT

For the first time ever, paws4people was the recipient of a \$350,000 state funded grant toward our programming. This grant was advocated by Senator Michael Lee. Senator Lee and his son, Sawyer, visited paws4people National Headquarters in October.

We are so grateful for the support of Senator Lee and that he took time out of his busy schedule to visit our Campus. We look forward to expanding our programming in North Carolina, which includes deepening our relationship with the NC Department of Corrections.

4 OTHERS FOUNDATION GRANT

For the second year in a row, paws4people was the recipient of a \$10,000 matching grant from the 4 Others Foundation. Thanks to generosity of our paws4people Clients, family, friends, and supporters, this year's grant money will be put towards building and launching an ADDIE'S Way website in 2023. We look forward to having a digital platform to showcase our headquarters' campus to the world.



Dog of the Year

paws4people hosted our first annual Dog of the Year Contest beginning in November with an end date and time of midnight on New Year's Eve. Participants from all over the country were able to nominate and vote for their dog and tell us why they should be the Dog of the Year.

Josie!

When the clock struck midnight, Josie, a rescue mutt who was adopted in Charlotte, NC from the Humane Society, was dubbed the official 2023 Dog of the Year. Josie received more than 5,700 votes in the contest. This first ever, fully digital contest raised over \$30,000 in support of our mission and programs.

Josie is now the spokesdog for the Dog of the Year contest, after beating out more than 121 other dog entries. Josie received several prizes, including an artist drawing of the winning dog featured on the label of a limited run of Wrightsville Beach Brewery Pale Ale Beer can, \$500 cash prize, \$100 gift certificate to Wrightsville Beach Brewery, mini photography session valued at \$400 by Samantha Ann Photography, a framed commemorative artwork of the beer can, PNG files of artist Emma Gay's renderings of the winning dog in black and white and in color sent digitally via email, and special recognition at a Brewery event.

We look forward to the beer release in early 2023.




