

paws4people® was honored to receive a \$700,000 state-funded grant to support the development of the new BRADIE Training Center.

Additionally, it will serve as a venue for larger events and classrooms, enabling us to expand the reach and impact of ADDIE'S Way. We are proud to announce that paws4people® Founder, and Executive Director Kyria Henry Whisenhunt has been elected to the Board of Directors for Assistance Dogs International (ADI).

ADI is a worldwide coalition of not-for-profit organizations that train and place Assistance Dogs. Founded in 1986 from a group of seven small organizations, ADI has become the leading authority in the Assistance Dog industry. Members of ADI meet regularly to share ideas and conduct business regarding educating the public about Assistance Dogs, advocating for the legal rights of people with disabilities partnered with Assistance Dogs, and the setting of standards and establishing guidelines and ethics for the training of these dogs. We look forward to watching Kyria's collaborative work within ADI over the next four years.



DOG OF THE YEAR

PROGRAM UPDATE

UNCW/paws4people® Assistance Dog Training Program (ADTP)



The Assistance Dog Training Program (ADTP) at UNCW continues to be a highlight of many students' college experience. This first-of-its-kind program focuses on teaching students how to train Assistance Dogs in public settings, the life-changing impact these dogs have on individuals with disabilities, and their use in professional environments.

Students gain hands-on experience training Service and Facility Dogs and have the option to take an in-depth course on Facility Dogs, preparing them for future careers as recreation therapists, social workers, mental health practitioners, healthcare providers, and teachers. This program continues to shape the next generation of professionals while making a meaningful difference in the lives of people with disabilities.


